Target audience: Authors.

This training is intended for functional managers, the persons in charge of the **management of the workspaces and the users** of a Scenari environment .

Objectives

- Know how to manage users and groups of users;
- Understand the notion of role and know how to assign it to a user or a group, on a given perimeter;
- Know how to create and manage the workspaces.

Program

1 — Users and access rights management

- Presentation of the notions of user / group / roles / scope / rights.
- Users management (creation / modification / deactivation / deletion), authentication modes (internal, Idap) and groups management (creation / deletion / assignation).

2 — Workspaces management

- Presentation of the concepts of server and workspaces (reference / derived and work layers / public).
- Workspaces creation.

3 — Collaborative writing process

The participants are invited to define the features that would allow them to instrument their collaborative writing process: co-writing / proofreading / validation, life cycle, tasks, etc.

Pedagogy and tools

Educational principles

- The training is focused on the practice: the manipulation of the Scenari production environment through exercises;
- The terminology and concepts are introduced as the training progresses;
- The training is adjusted to your needs, manipulations are done in an identical or very similar environment to your production environment.

Tools

- An open source publishing chain, accessible on a server made available for the duration of the training,
- · The webconference system,
- Access to Learn portal, where administrative and pedagogical documents are centralized as well as questionnaires (positioning, satisfaction, evaluation).
